## Your NHS OpenAthens Account

## NICE Core Content for NHS-commissioned health care students

If you are a student on an NHS-commissioned programme of study, involving practice and placement with NHS service provider, then you are eligible to access NICE Core Content for the duration of your course. Access is provided to Higher Education Institutions via OpenAthens under an agreement with National Institute for Health and Care Excellence and Health Education England (NICE).

You will be provided with an OpenAthens account at the start of your course. Look out for an email from <<u>athens-noreply@eduserv.org.uk</u>> asking you to activate your account and accept the terms and conditions. Contact <<u>elibrary@brunel.ac.uk</u>> to ask for assistance if you do not receive an email or if you do not activate your account within 30 days.Once your account is active you may start using the provided by NICE to the NHS.

## **Available Content**

Your OpenAthens account gives you access to NICE's core <u>resource hub</u> provided to the NHS, including:

- Bibliographic databases provided by: EBSCOhost (<u>Psychology and</u> <u>Behavioural Sciences Collection</u>); Ovid (AMED (Allied and Complementary Medicine), Embase, Ovid EMCARE, HMIC Health Management Information Consortium, and Ovid MEDLINE - select "OpenAthens I Institutional" link and then find "Brunel University London NHS in England" to log in); and ProQuest (<u>Health Research Premium</u> <u>Collection</u> and <u>PsycARTICLES</u> – search for "NICE" and then find "NHS in England" to log in).
- <u>e-Learning for Healthcare (e-LfH)</u> select the "Sign on with OpenAthens" button.
- <u>BMJ Best Practice</u> sign in via "Brunel University London NHS in England".
- <u>Cochrane Library; Stem Cell Evidence Library</u> and <u>Transfusion</u> <u>Evidence Library</u>.
- <u>HDAS (Healthcare Databases for the NHS in England)</u> a unified search service including Medline, EMBASE and CINAHL.
- Journals A to Z.
- British National Formulary (BNF) and British National Formulary for Children(BNFC) – access via NICE or sign up for the free mobile

These resources are also accessible directly via suppliers' websites when you sign invia OpenAthens.

However, they are **not** listed on Brunel Library's own Library resources (including theLibrary search tool, the e-Journals A to Z, or the Databases A-Z web pages) and, therefore, will not be linked when conducting searches using your Brunel accounts.
